



Leadership Mohawk Valley

Leadership Mohawk Valley was established in 1990 in response to a need for greater community leadership, civic responsibility, and community trusteeship. LMV participants broaden their perspectives and confront the issues facing our community, thereby gaining a clearer picture of the community as it exists today. Ultimately, the 10-month program concludes by creating a new pool of 30 to 35 future leaders, better informed and prepared to go forward and to serve the communities where they live and work.

The Leadership Mohawk Valley program begins with a day and a half of orientation. From September to May, participants meet one day each month for a "Program Day" designed to inform and educate the class on the various aspects of what shapes our local community and national policy. Each of these days is a different topic or subject presented by community leaders, content experts, elected officials, educators, etc.

In addition, class members are placed into small teams and are given carefully selected community projects to work on during the 10 month program. The culmination of these projects is a formal presentation to members of the community at which team members outline the scope of their project and the recommendations and/or final outcomes of their collective efforts.
